WHO'S COMING TO THE CAREER FAIR?

WHAT DO YOU SUGGEST I DO PRIOR TO THE CAREER FAIR TO BE READY?

Before the fair, download the Career Fair Plus app to review employers, check out the map and know what each company is looking for.

WILL THERE BE A BAG POLICY?

Bags will not be allowed inside McCamish and will require bag check outside across Fowler so do not bring anything you are not comfortable leaving unattended. All attendees will be required to pass through metal detectors and security screenings upon entering the arena, for this reason we highly discourage bags and recommend you travel light. You should expect all other safety issues to be handled exactly the way they are on GT Game day. There will be on-site security at the fair.

WILL TRANSPORTATION BE PROVIDED?

Ensure though that you dress professionally to show your potential employer that you take the job opportunity seriously. This means no ripped clothing, no flip flops, and no revealing attire permitted.
